In Soucieu-en-Jarrest, in a privileged environment just 30 minutes from Lyon, this 259sqm stone house is located in the heart of a 14,000 sqm wooded plot. Surrounded by greenery and featuring an orchard with fruit trees, it offers a clear panorama of the Monts du Lyonnais and a unique view of a Roman aqueduct, a rare heritage vestige. The entrance is through a vast hall leading to a living/dining room bathed in natural light, enhanced by large openings and exposed beams. The independent, functional kitchen opens onto the surrounding landscape. On the same level, an office with a fireplace offers an ideal space for teleworking, with direct access to the terrace.

A master suite completes this level, with a private bathroom and separate toilet. Upstairs, two comfortable bedrooms each have their own shower room and toilet, guaranteeing privacy and comfort. The 150 sqm basement accommodates a spare bedroom, a shower room, a toilet, a laundry room, a large garage and a workshop, offering numerous development possibilities. Outside, the landscaped grounds reveal wide views of the surrounding nature.

The carefully maintained green spaces, the orchard and the sunny terrace create a living space in total harmony with nature. This rare property with its authentic charm, calm atmosphere and dominant view will appeal to lovers of character and nature. 
