A small quiet communal road separates the main house from the small gite, garage, and storeroom. This road leads to one neighbor, ensuring a calm location. The small gite is compact but functional, featuring a sitting area, kitchenette, shower room, and toilet downstairs. The sleeping area is a mezzanine under the eaves.

This small unit has its own private garden overlooking the fields. Additional features include a workshop, chicken pen, garage, and one more outbuilding. It's a very tranquil location, despite the communal road that divides the property.

There is a bakery in Marmagne just 5 minutes away, with other shops in Etang sur Arroux, Autun, and Le Creusot, all around 15 minutes away. The property is also 15 minutes from Le Creusot Montchanin TGV station. It has mains drainage and fiber optic internet access.
