## **Property Description**

One of a kind 500-year history Manor property nestled in the heart of this emblematic village between vineyards and mountains on the Alsace Wine Route. Located in the hollow of the Vosges hills, this exceptional residence has been listed as a Historic Monument since 1932 by the French Ministry of Culture. Acquired in 2018, the building has been undergoing a major renovation. The quality of the materials used and the care taken in its restoration are perfectly in keeping with the 500-year history of this unique house.

#### THE MANSION

The building develops a living area of 346 sqm to which is added 257sqm of additional spaces (cellars, attic, garage) and is structured on 4 levels distributed as follows:

- On the ground floor overlooking the courtyard: a vault adjoining a garage used as a technical room (heating system and networks, storage, etc.)
- On the first floor: a 3-room apartment of 124 sqm composed of an entrance hall leading to a master suite, a toilet, a living / dining room giving access to the oriel window and an independent and equipped kitchen
- On the second floor: a 4-room apartment of 127 sqm articulated around an entrance hall leading to 2 bedrooms, a living room with access to the oriel window, a bathroom, a toilet and a dining room decorated with an equipped kitchen separated by a glass door and a 53 sqm terrace completing its top-of-the-range characteristics
- In the attic: housed under the roof, a 2-room apartment of 50 sqm and attic spaces for additional development potential increased to 96 sqm.

The floors of the main building are all served by a magnificent freestone spiral staircase in a square profile turret accessible by a door with a molded door frame surmounted by a segmental arched lintel carved in the center.

A wing extends the house and consists of 3 cellars accessible from the courtyard, overhung by a 45 sqm apartment currently used as a **guest apartment** composed by a bedroom, a kitchen and a bathroom with toilet.

*Outside*, the courtyard easily allows the parking of **3 vehicles**.

#### ABOUT THE AREA AND ACCESS

The strategic location of this exceptional property, close to shops and amenities within walking distance, equidistant from Sélestat and Colmar, essential tourist and cultural stops in Alsace, both close to the main axes while being away major tourist flows, constitutes an undeniable potential and gives it a major asset. Close to the German and Swiss borders.

- Access to the A35 motorway in 8 minutes.
- High-speed train station 20 minutes away, connecting Paris in 3 hours.
- EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse and Strasbourg-Entzheim airport, 40 minutes away, serve many international lines.


