Property Description

This charming house, approximately 125 sq.m in size, is built in cut stone and covered in slate. It is set back from the street in a village with shops. The property features a paved and landscaped courtyard leading to the house, which has three levels of living space.

The ground floor includes a fitted and equipped kitchen with courtyard access, a living room with a dining area and a fireplace with Polyflam fireplace system, a laundry room, and a separate toilet.

On the first floor, you'll find three bedrooms with parquet flooring and a marble fireplace, an office, and a bathroom with a toilet. The top floor houses a large master suite with a bedroom and a separate dressing room, which can be converted into a future bathroom.

The property also includes a terrace and a garden at the back, as well as a garage with a new motorised door accessible from the street. It is heated by a newly installed air/water heat pump and has undergone numerous renovations, including the roof (2012), facade and garage, paved courtyard, heating system, and insulation with rock wool. Some finishing work is needed to fully reveal the property's potential.

The property is conveniently located within a 5-minute walk to the nursery, primary school, and essential shops. Additionally, it is 19 km from Compiègne, 21 km from Villers-Cotterêts, and 25 km from Soissons. The Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport is 70 km away.


