This old hay barn and its stables, located in the historic heart of Viarmes, benefits from a pretty private garden with trees, complete with a car port with an electric vehicle socket. A beautiful entrance renovated with cement tiles delivers a great height under the ridge, welcoming the mezzanine dedicated to the offices of the parents. On the left wing, a recent fitted kitchen continues with a laundry room with shower, then a guest bedroom. The latter offers access to the garage or workshop from the inside. The Norman-style reception

room, with exposed beams, is dressed in old floor tiles, open fireplace and access to a beautiful terrace topped with a sculptural weeping willow. The parental floor develops an atypical bathroom with a 'lion's feet' bathtub and earthenware basin 'beginning of the century' as well as a bedroom with parquet floor with integrated cupboards and old alcove. The children's open space on the last level is dressed in an exposed frame with high ceilings. The intimate garden, not overlooked, is planted with trees and enclosed by stone walls. A vaulted cellar completes the set with outside access. All amenities are within walking distance.


