Property Description

This charming period chateau is situated north of Tours and south of Le Mans, it comes with a lovely 12 acres /4.8 hectares enclosed estate with a restored logis and numerous outbuildings. There's excellent access to one of the best villages in the area and a short 30 minute drive to Tours and its TGV with direct access to Paris.

THE ACCOMMODATION IN THE CHATEAU

The chateau today offers over 425 sqm of living space over 3 floors with many original features retained. The ground floor provides a formal "front to back" entrance hall with quarry tiled floor and oak staircase, this leads to the left to the double aspect lounge with feature fabric murals representing the chateau and its logis, exposed ceiling beams, this room has a great relaxed fell to it and enjoys plenty of natural light. From here we discover the dining hall with feature period stone fireplace and access direct to a small kitchen in the tower room and also a wc and service staircase.

To the other side of the entrance hall we have a formal dining hall or office with oak parquet floors and panelled walls leading to a hexagonal library and 2nd wc.

Two staircases (service and the main) lead to the *1st floor* where we discover a corridor leading to master hexagonal bedroom with views over the gardens and private bathroom, 4 other bedrooms and 3 bathrooms and wc. A mix of original parquet flooring and carpets on this floor.

The *2nd floor* has a large galerie with parquet floor leading to 4 more bedrooms including another hexagonal one with dressing room and 3 bathrooms. There is an attic space above with charming timberwork ... this could be converted if required. The chateau has a slate roof in good condition and some double glazing, the heating and drainage systems will need upgrading.

ACCOMMODATION IN THE LOGIS

The logis has been completely restored and offers over 145 sqm of living space over 2 floors: large living room with beams and tiled floor, fitted kitchen and another large lounge/diner. On the 1st floor we have a parental suite and 2nd bedroom with separate bathroom and an attic above. The roof again is in slate and very good condition, the building is double glazed and has a underfloor heat pump system on the ground floor.

OUTBUILDINGS

- The outbuildings consits of a good sized garage 35 sqm, a workshop of 50 sqm + 50 sqm above, shelter of 60 sqm, 2 vaulted caves and a kennel.
- The land is completley enclosed with a courtyard access via a pretty avenue.
- The park is well established with specimen trees, there's an orchard and vegetable area, paddock, woodland and two ponds.

A great location with excellent access to a very popular local town and easy access to the A28 motorway and Tours.




