Elegant Castle with a Lovely Park and Land between Tours and Le Mans

Property Description

This elegant castle built in the middle of a beautiful English-style park is situated in a hilly and wooded countryside, at a distance of 40 km from Tours. It takes just 52 minutes from Paris by TGV or airport.

The Castle

With a living area of approximately 1080 sq.m, the castle is divided into different floors. The ground floor boasts an entrance with a wrought iron bannister staircase, a gallery, a small living room (39 sq.m.), a large living room (74 sq.m.) with beautiful decorative elements such as a fireplace, trumeau, and woodwork, a library, a large dining room that has been decorated with trumeaux, a kitchen, and a toilet.

On the first floor, there are 5 bedrooms, 5 bathrooms with toilets, and an office. The second floor comprises of 4 bedrooms, 4 bathrooms with toilets (two with bathtubs, two with showers), and a suite consisting of two bedrooms, a bathroom with toilet, and a dressing room. On the garden level, there is an old kitchen (74 sq.m.) with a monumental fireplace, utility rooms, a heated swimming pool measuring 9 x 4 m, and a beautiful vaulted room serving as a cloakroom.

Large Circular Building

A semi-circular outbuilding of magnificent size, with a total surface area of 1330 sq.m on 2 levels, houses various amenities such as a six-room caretaker's accommodation with oil heating, stables, garages, an enormous old kitchen, cellars, and service rooms, and old bedrooms that cover 358 sq.m. of living space.

The 17th-Century Chapel

The castle also features a 17th-century chapel with a vaulted room below, a dovecote fitted out with a billiard room and a library, and a caretaker's lodge at the entrance to the property.

Step Outside to the English Park & Pool Area

The property boasts a vegetable garden with a greenhouse (to be restored), tennis court, infinity pool measuring 7 x 15 m, heated by a heat pump, and a superb English-style park. The property is set on approximately 22 ha of land.

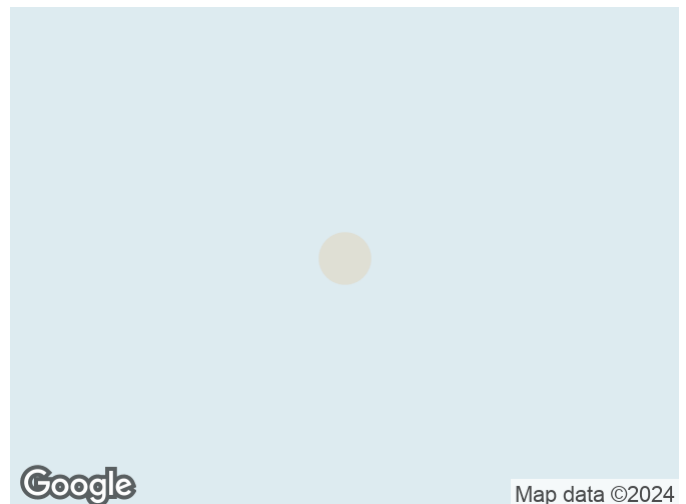
