On an old enclosed hovel, architect-designed house, in the heart of a lush garden of 6908 m2, with outbuildings, 30 minutes from the sea and 6 km from Auffay, Saine-Maritime (76), for sale.

Built in 1967, on an old enclosed hovel, which still retains its old press, this comfortable architect-designed house, bathed in light, offers a living space of 198 m2. The residence is surrounded by a lush garden which invites itself into the house, thanks to its numerous bay windows.

Once through the entrance, you enter the heart of the house, into a large living room, decorated with a fireplace.

The living room opens onto a terrace, facing south, where it is a good place to have lunch in the summer.

Continuing on, we find a fitted and equipped kitchen and a corridor leading to 2 bedrooms, 1 bathroom with toilet, a laundry room.

The ground floor also serves a cloakroom with visitor toilets. On the 1st floor of the house a large landing room opens onto 4 other bedrooms and a bathroom with toilet.

With skilfully designed spaces and living spaces, independent of each other, this house offers a comfortable living environment. Its distribution allows a 'bed and breakfast' activity. Carefully maintained, no work is required.

The other strong point of the property is its quite exceptional environment where the garden takes a prominent place.

Maintained with great care, many floral and shrub varieties coexist there, leaving plenty of room for rose bushes. Not far from the house stands a half-timbered and cob outbuilding, which formerly housed the press. Rehabilitated into a home, it offers a surface area of 190 m2 to which must be added an attic of 100 m2.

At the back of the property, we can see the second outbuilding (60 m2), currently used as a workshop, also rehabilitable, and all around, the orchard of the closed hovel and a henhouse.

Quietly, in an environment where nature offers the best, this architect-designed house offers an exceptional place to live, close to shops (Auffay 6 km), not far from the sea, 30 minutes ( Dieppe). Golf Saint Saëns 12 km away. The land is suitable for swimming pools.
