## **Property Description**

In the heart of a small village in the Pays de Bray, Anglo-Norman manor house with outbuildings, extending over 2.6 hectares of land, a few minutes from Gournay-en-Bray, Seine-Maritime (76), for sale. Labeled 'Remarkable House', this residence built between 1860 and 1870 was designed by its owner with the desire to display all the codes of the 19th century bourgeoisie. The house will have several owners, incredible stories until 1978, after which, it remained in the same family. In the architecture, we find all the codes of the neo-Norman style. Once past the threshold of the house, it is the decorative characteristics of the Napoleon III era

that are imposed, an eclectic style mixing the influences of the past. At the entrance, a charming peristyle invites you to stroll. Crossing the front door, the residence opens onto a vast entrance distributing a small living room with fireplace, a large living room and its astonishing stone fireplace with high relief. In continuity, the office refers to a kitchen, a toilet, a dining room, an office and access to a veranda. A superb staircase provides access to the 1st floor as well as a beautiful landing room distributing 5 bedrooms, 1 shower room, 1 bathroom and a toilet. The second floor offers another 4 bedrooms and 2 bathrooms with toilet. From the first floor, you can access the north tower, and benefit, from its observatory in a beautiful space converted into a library, from an extraordinary view of the property and the Brayon countryside. With a living area of 453 m2, the house also benefits from a full basement. The manor is surrounded by 26,568 m2 of land, shared between a park with century-old trees and pastures. This manor has also benefited from major technological improvements (geothermal heating and photovoltaic panels). All around the house, there is an old greenhouse (to be restored), a small neo-Norman style caretaker's house, an outbuilding of approximately 144 m<sup>2</sup> on the ground, which can be converted into a home and, adjoining, 2 lean-tos and 3 horse boxes. A few minutes from Gournay, shops and all services, this bourgeois residence offers significant potential. Beyond the family home, it can accommodate various tourist projects: gîtes and guest rooms. 2 hours from Paris, 20 minutes from Sergueux SNCF train station (Paris), 5 minutes from Gournay-en-Bray train station (Rouen). 





