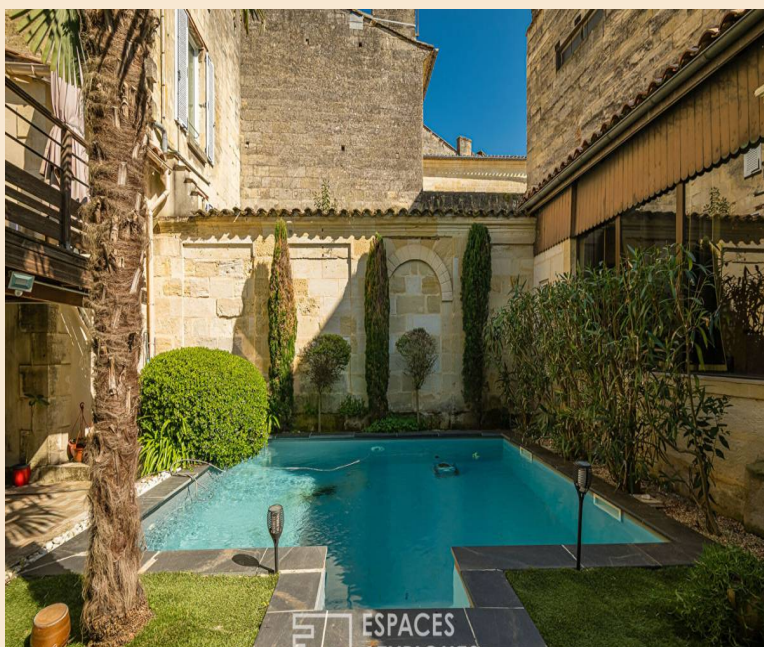

Nestled among the lively streets of central Libourne, this elegant stone house offers approximately 175 sqm of living space, spread over three levels, and offers a refined, warm, and rare living environment in the heart of the city.

From the entrance, the charm is felt: moldings, parquet floors, and brightness welcome you into this setting. The open kitchen, clad in light wood and highlighted by a typical blond stone wall, combines modernity and character. The whole extends onto a suspended terrace overlooking an intimate garden where a heated swimming pool is enthroned, inviting you to relax.

Upstairs, two beautiful, bright bedrooms share a shower room, while the top level is entirely dedicated to a characterful master suite: spacious bedroom, bathroom, separate toilet and independent dressing room make up this perfectly designed sleeping area. In the basement, a laundry room, a multipurpose room and a cellar complete the ensemble.

A real asset: an outbuilding of approximately 60 sqm, converted into an apartment with a separate entrance, offers multiple possibilities: seasonal rental, hosting friends or professional space.

Between quality services, generous volumes and city life on foot, this rare house brilliantly combines comfort, authenticity and elegance. All shops and the train station are accessible in a few minutes on foot.
