Property Description

Located on the outskirts of a Gascon village between Nérac and Condom in the Lot-et-Garonne region, this château, which is listed as a historical monument, boasts approximately 830 sqm of living space and offers a stunning panoramic view of the rolling landscape of the Albret area. The Renaissance-style entrance pavilion provides a glimpse of the elegant Italian garden, featuring yew and cypress topiaries, an orangery, and a

dovecote.

The Gascon château features spacious living areas filled with natural light, and has preserved its authenticity with two round towers dating back to medieval times. During the Renaissance era, the château was renovated with the addition of a tower featuring a grand stone staircase, as well as an entrance pavilion with a sentry room on the first floor. The former stables were converted into an orangery.

The property boasts a range of architectural treasures, including fireplaces, mullioned windows, exposed beams and stonework, and decorative elements such as the Italian-style garden, fountain, basin, and statue, which all add to the ambiance of a bygone era steeped in history.

The 7-hectare estate is composed of an orchard and walnut trees, and is situated in a serene environment that is equidistant from Bordeaux and Toulouse (1.5 hours from both airports, and 30 minutes from Port-Sainte-Marie train station).




