### Property Description

Located in Lot-et-Garonne in the Nouvelle Aquitaine region, between the towns of Nérac and Condom, this castle is listed as an ISMH and boasts a living area of 832 square metres.

The Renaissance entrance pavilion gives a view of the Italian garden, which includes yews and cypresses. There is also an entrance pavilion with sentry room upstairs (30 sq.m), awning, garage (30 sq.m), orangery (120 sq.m), dovecote (30 sq.m), châtelet with a vaulted room (28 sq.m) and upper floor (28 sq.m), and a small walled garden, accessible via a 14th-century Gothic bridge, adding to the old-world charm. 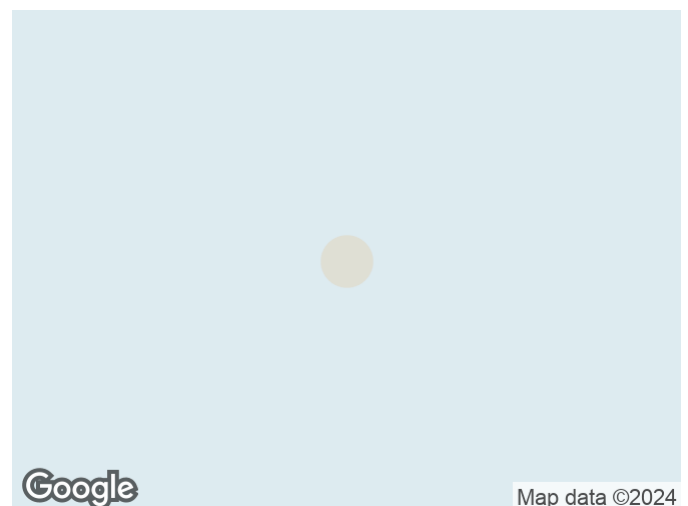
