The ground floor is comprised of a generous entrance hall of 15m², a 17m² fitted kitchen, a 25m² living room with wood burner and a 22m² sitting room, also with wood burner.

A passageway leads to a 5m² washroom, a toilet, a 14m² larder and a 25m² wine press.

Upstairs are three bedrooms (20m², 23m² & 27m²) as well as a 14m² study and a 19m² space currently serving as storage room.

Outside, there is a covered yard and numerous outbuildings including a hay barn, livestock barn, henhouse and pigsty. There is a well which you can use for watering your plants.

Around half of the windows are double glazed. The roof is covered in tile. There is no central heating, only the wood burners. The property is served by an individual sewage system.


