It has more than 480 sqm of living space, divided into 9 apartments with comfortable surfaces, six T2 and three T3. The three floors that make up this building are served by an elevator to ensure optimal comfort for its occupants. The type 2 apartments have

two different designs but all equally functional. For one, an entrance hallway serves the bathroom/shower room, the separate toilet and the bedroom. It ends on the living room with open kitchen. Finally, a storeroom/laundry room completes the set. For the second, the entrance door opens directly onto the living room, always open. The night space is separate and is articulated as in a suite. As for the T3, the entrance hall serves the different rooms and splits the living and night rooms on either side. They are through and offer beautiful light. Each apartment has the chance to benefit from an individual garage. Seven additional garages are rented independently. Fully rented, it ensures an interesting profitability (information on request).
