Character, village house in stone, already renovated, on a quiet street and square in the heart of the village. Once two houses, now joined together, allowing volumes of space on different levels, the property has many original features and rustic charm. It offers 137 m² of living space over three levels, comprising of a comfortable lounge opening onto the dining area and a brand new fitted kitchen, 3/4 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, a garage, a covered veranda and an attic room which can be uncovered and made into an open roof terrace. A solid house with rustic charm, already renovated, ideally suited for year around living or an easy holiday home.

Ground = Entrance hall of 4 m² + nice bedroom of 12 m² (or perfect office) + garage of 40 m² with new electric shutter door (ample space for parking 1-2 small cars and tools/workshop) + utility area of 10 m² with sink.
