Behind a discreet facade typical of the region, this elegant 18th-century Toulouse house offers approximately 280 sqm of living space on two levels, nestled in a 1100 sqm green setting. Tastefully redesigned, the renovation reveals its original character. Exposed beams, cement tiles, generous volumes, and floodlights create a warm and sophisticated atmosphere. The ground floor features a vast, open-plan living room of 70

sqm, bathed in light and facing the garden. The separate, fully equipped kitchen flows smoothly as an extension of the living space. Two closed lounges complete this level, providing space for multiple uses: office, library, TV room, or spare bedrooms. Upstairs, the sleeping area is organized around a mezzanine opening onto the living room, creating a subtle link between the two levels. Four bedrooms are located here, each with its own bathroom, for optimal comfort. At the rear of the house, the landscaped garden stretches out, hidden from view. A north-facing terrace, a pétanque court, and a dedicated swimming pool and jacuzzi area: the exterior naturally extends the house's art of living. A carport and several private parking spaces within the plot allow for easy parking.
