There are two ways to access: via a wooden porch and via a gate which leads to an alleyway which opens to a big parking area where a carport can house three vehicles including a motor home.

The ground floor has a contemporary open kitchen, a cosy living room with fireplace, a study, a bedroom, bathroom and a toilet this offering the possibility to dwell only on this floor. The 28m² living room has access to the garden via the patio doors will allow lots of natural light.

Upstairs, a landing serves two 14m² bedrooms, a washroom with toilet, a 31m² games room with wooden flooring and a superb master bedroom with a 10m² walk-in wardrobe and a private terrace with open view of the countryside.

The 2000m² of land has trees and is bordered by a stream and is a haven of tranquility. It has a wood shelter and a big south-facing wooden terrace, perfect for relaxing with friends and family and is protected by a pebble wall and a luxuriant vegetation.

Construction is traditional, the roof of the house and barn are recent, windows are double glazed (except the walk-in wardrobe). Heating is provided by wood and electricity. The property is served by an individual sewage system.
