Outside, the landscaped garden unfolds around a beautiful heated swimming pool (5 x 10 m), a true haven of relaxation. Nearby, a charming dovecote typical of the region - with a silhouette as elegant as it is symbolic - awaits to be reinvented as an additional living space: an artist's studio, an unusual suite, a wellness area, or an office with a view? 
