

From the entrance, the tone is set: the main living space impresses with its generous volume, highlighted by a cathedral ceiling and large bay windows that bathe the room in light throughout the day. It is naturally extended by a contemporary, fully equipped and fitted kitchen. A pantry/laundry room extends this space. On the other side of the ground floor, a bedroom with a shower room and separate toilet complete this level. Upstairs, the staircase leads to a rock garden converted into an office/library while overlooking the living room. A hallway leads to three beautiful bedrooms, including a master bedroom with a private shower room. The other two bedrooms share a sleek bathroom and offer access to a roof terrace. The garden benefits from a sheltered terrace, directly accessible from the living room, and a green setting sheltered from view. This land allows the construction of a swimming pool.
