

Ground floor = 3.80 m2 entrance hall with separate toilet and wash basin + large 70 m2 living room with lounge/dining room with traditional fireplace and spacious kitchen + 3 m2 utility room + 5.7 m2 linen room + access to 38 m2 garage with central heating system.

1st = Very light hallway + pretty, bright 6.80 m2 bathroom with window (shower, bath, washbasin, wc) + 3 bedrooms (with fitted cupboards) of 14 m2, 13.50 m2 and 15 m2 (the latter with direct access to the terrace) + 45 m2 terrace with barbecue and sink unit.

2nd = Large convertible attic with a main room of about 30 m2 and two rooms of about 17 m2 each (possibility of terrace).

Miscellaneous = Oil-fired central heating (de Dietrich) + reversible air conditioning + fireplace with heat recovery units + house completely renovated in a traditional style (plasterwork, brick partitions, etc. here no plasterboard!) + high ceilings + light + guaranteed annual income thanks to the photovoltaic panels on the new roof (2400 Euros) + double glazing throughout + 1100 Euros property tax.


