Located between Gaillac and Lisle sur Tarn, in the heart of a preserved wine-growing landscape, this former farmhouse from 1925 offers nearly 300 sqm of living space. Arranged in two adjoining dwellings, it offers the possibility of combining the spaces to create a large family home, or of keeping the current layout (ideal for a reception business or a dual-purpose residence) but also of reinventing the distribution between the two spaces. This atypical property offers a total of six bedrooms, four bathrooms and several bright living rooms, all with authentic charm. The first dwelling reveals, from the entrance, a warm atmosphere with a spacious living room of nearly 45 sqm, a dining room with an open kitchen and a functional laundry room as well as a bathroom with WC. This level also includes, on the other side, two bedrooms and then upstairs a mezzanine, as well as a bathroom with WC. The main floor serves three additional bedrooms, a bathroom and a separate toilet, all enhanced by a careful decoration that respects the spirit of the place. The second accommodation, a former workshop transformed into a loft, is organized around a large living room with a pellet stove, a dining room with an open kitchen and scullery, a suite with a dressing room, shower room and separate toilet. An elegant wooden library adorns the staircase leading to a mezzanine, overlooking the generous volumes of the main room under exposed roof timbers. Outside, the plot of more than 5000 sqm is planted with trees and decorated with a well. On the outbuilding side, the property has an old barn of approximately 100 sqm on the ground, currently composed of a workshop, a closed summer kitchen as well as a large lean-to. A raw space still remains available upstairs. The natural setting, surrounded by vineyards and not overlooked, invites relaxation and conviviality. This unique property, a subtle blend of authenticity and atypical volumes, will appeal to lovers of generous spaces looking for a place steeped in history near Gaillac.
