The swimming pool is new, salt water, 12x5 and has an additional shelter.

The property is in good condition with double glazing for a small part, heating by wood or pellet stoves, individual NC drainage, fibre optics, some parts of the building have been renovated recently including the lounge, gym, bedrooms on the second floor ..., roof insulated (some parts recently), electricity redone approx 15 years,

In addition, there are a number of other advantages: potential for seasonal accommodation in the 3 gîtes, which offer excellent value for money, photovoltaic panels (1000€/year), possible electricity production thanks to water rights (a water supply canal runs through the house and there is an old system there). Large area of land with river and canal, close to Foix in the beautiful Barguillère valley, approx. 1h15 from Toulouse. Great potential for a family looking to set up in the countryside and run a seasonal hospitality business.


