It is composed on 3 levels comprising commercial premises, 3 to 4 bedrooms, a large living room with open kitchen, a washroom, the all right in the heart of center, few meters from the commodities and with a parking nearby !

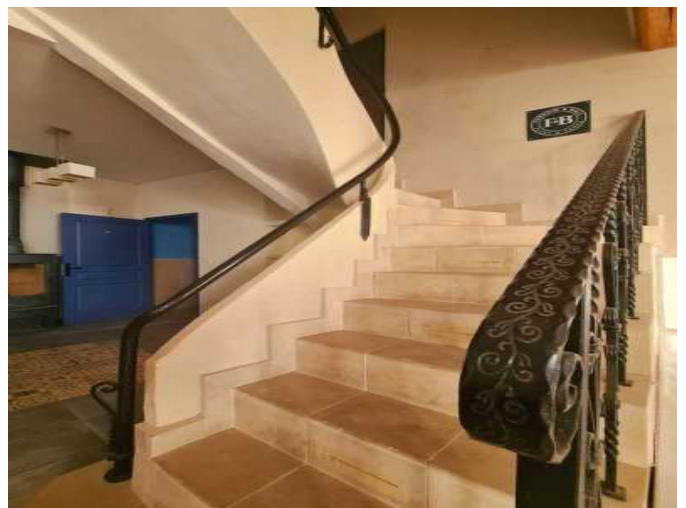
