Property Description

This property is a stone house with unique woodwork situated in a magical and idyllic setting within the grounds of a historic estate in Aude, Occitanie.

The property is conveniently located just 5 minutes away from a village with all amenities and services. The

city of Carcassonne and its airport are 15 minutes away, while Bram, the entrance to the motorway, is just 6 minutes away.

The property offers a generous living area of 249 sqm and will charm you with its beautiful finishes, character, location away from other homes, and its existing potential, as the interior is modular.

Upon entering the property, you'll find a bright entrance leading to the living area, dining room, fully equipped open kitchen, and access to an incredible library on two levels. The library is a curiosity, as it is overlooked by a mobile bridge upstairs. It could easily become an additional bedroom with a bathroom. In continuity, two cellars follow one another. In the other wing, completely independent, is a studio/gite with a small kitchen, living room/bedroom, bathroom, WC, and cupboard.

Upstairs, you can access the second part of the library, which could be easily turned into another bedroom. Additionally, a second living area could be converted into a bedroom as there's already a toilet and a separate bathroom. On this same level, a lovely bedroom with a dressing room, bathroom, and a private terrace with views of the garden and the park is also available.
