With a surface area of 115 m² (23.00 mx 5.00) and a deck area of 24.00 m² (4.00 mx 6.00 m) this non-navigating and non-couple river dwelling can be lived like a house on the water and combines singularity and comfort within a privileged environment.

The view of the Seine is conducive to escape by offering a privileged perspective on the Parisian monuments.

The house benefits from an open-air terrace and a comfortable living space. This traditional ship, where exotic wood reigns supreme and spreads harmoniously in each room, bears witness to the history of river navigation and has retained all its original charm.

After a flight of stairs, from the entrance a beautiful living space develops which brings together a kitchen with a counter dressed in brass and wood as well as a lounge area organized around a warm wood stove.

As in a loft, the space is extended by a line of storage. On one side, two bedrooms and their bathroom which are adorned with cleverly fitted dressing rooms for an optimal layout. Offices are also cleverly hidden.

On the other side, a third bedroom also has its own bathroom.
