Property Description

Located in a privileged and suburban area of ??Noisy le Grand, close to the theater and the market, this house from 2005 develops 234m² of living space on two levels and has landscaped and wooded grounds of 1346m².

The entrance hall opens onto a 50 m² living room, the open kitchen and laundry room, a master suite consisting of a corridor with storage, a dressing room, a bedroom and its bathroom. A clearance allows access to the boiler room and the adjoining garage which can accommodate two cars. The large bay window which opens onto the south-west facing terrace brings constant light to the master suite as well as the dining room. An independent toilet completes the ground floor.

On the first floor, the 28 m² landing (possibility of creating an office room) leads to three bedrooms, one of which has its own bathroom and spa bath, a second with a shower room and toilet as well as a room that can be used as a dressing room. and independent toilets. A terrace serves two of the bedrooms.

At the back of the plot there is an outbuilding of approximately 47m² currently serving as a garage for three cars.

Exterior lighting, like the shutters and the alarm are managed by home automation. Hot water comes mainly from photovoltaic panels located on the roof.

This property is a true haven of peace opening onto the greenery, not overlooked, quiet, ideal for a family, close to the nursery, schools, shops.
