This charming 1930 house is located in the heart of the old village of Marly le Roi, a stone's throw from the royal estate, close to its small shops and only a 10-minute walk from Marly train station, line L. The entrance opens onto the living room with fireplace, and in a row with the dining room, which together combine 32 sqm of reception. The descending staircase provides access to the large vaulted cellar/technical room of 23 sqm. The kitchen, in continuous, benefits from a storeroom. The first floor is composed of: on the left of a bedroom which connects a second entrance and benefits from a bathroom. On the right, a large office continues with a dressing room, a shower room and then a pretty bedroom. On the second floor, an office, a shower room, a dressing room and an attic bedroom reserve the plateau. This charming house is accompanied by a bucolic garden along its entire length of facade, facing south, with a pleasant terrace. Hidden, a small corner of orchard allows all the plantations, apple tree, pear tree, fig tree, raspberry bush, tomatoes and others A garage and a workshop complete the services of this property.
