Its surface area is 210 sqm spread over 2 levels, with a total finished basement of 100 sqm. A welcoming courtyard leads to an entrance leading to a spacious double living room with its fireplace and library for spending quality, friendly times. The living room and kitchen open onto a superb 70sqm wooden terrace facing south. The fully equipped 15sqm kitchen is very bright and functional. On one level you will find a first master bedroom with a bathroom and storage space. A pantry and a bathroom complete this level.
