The turret, accessible from the inside and outside of the building, offers a completely independent sleeping area with a bathroom and two beautiful bedrooms, one of which reveals a superb wooden frame and a small balcony with a breathtaking view on the garden and the surrounding area. A 14 m2 outbuilding with bedroom and bathroom, which can be connected to the main house, completes the services of this exceptional property, unique in the area. The complete renovation has transformed this building into a modern oasis while respecting period features such as arched windows and columns, thus offering the best of both worlds in a harmonious setting. 
