To the right, the bright, independent kitchen offers dual access to the entrance and dining room. The staircase leads down to a hallway with cupboards, a laundry room and its technical area. The first floor offers a beautiful bedroom and a large bathroom that it shares with the last attic bedroom on the top floor, which offers an office or a small playroom. Louveciennes train station, line L La Défense (trains every 13 minutes) is a 12-minute walk away. A13 is 2km away, for Boulogne Billancourt in 15 minutes. 10 minutes by car from Saint-Germain-en-Laye and Versailles. Forest is a 3-minute walk away, Marly Park is a 7-minute walk away.
