Nestled in the quiet pedestrian street of Paul Vaillant-Couturier, in the heart of Clamart town center, this 1930s townhouse is located within a small two-unit condominium. It offers a surface area of ??87.07 m² (113 m²) under the Carrez Law (113 m² floor area), plus a 43 m² basement. Just steps from shops, schools, and public transport, and in the immediate vicinity of Maison Blanche Park, it benefits from a rare location, where everything is within walking distance, in a lively and sought-after neighborhood. Renovation will be required to fully realize the site's potential.

Clamart town center charms with its lively, family-friendly atmosphere. It boasts a wide variety of shops, two renowned markets, as well as numerous restaurants and terraces. Cultural amenities are also plentiful, with the La Buanderie media library, an art-house cinema, a theater, and a dynamic cultural program throughout the year.

Spread over three main levels, the house is structured around a beautiful antique wooden staircase, a common thread between the floors. The ground floor has a separate entrance, while on the first floor, the heart of the house is revealed through a 36 m² dual-aspect living room, bathed in light, combining the living room, dining room, and open-plan kitchen. The living room opens onto a 23 m² terrace awaiting development, for which planning permission has already been granted. The second floor houses two 11 m² bedrooms and a recently renovated bathroom. The attic, converted into a sleeping area, completes the ensemble. Additionally, a vast 43 m² basement with several cellars provides valuable storage space.

This co-owned property, which feels like a home, has its own independent entrance. With no co-ownership fees, it captivates with its character, family-friendly layout, and great potential. Renovation is required to fully reveal this property's charm, and an extension is being considered, which is currently being reviewed by the town planning department. A rare property for those seeking a home-like atmosphere in the city center, in a living environment that is practical, vibrant, and privileged.
