The second level, created during an extension in 2003, houses a spacious bedroom with an en-suite bathroom, enhanced by exotic ipe wood flooring.

On the lower level, a bedroom with closets, a bathroom with toilet, and a laundry room complete the amenities.

Outside, a pleasant west-facing courtyard extends the house on two sides. Bordered by colorful facades, the private driveway surrounding the property offers a serene and green environment. Less than a 10-minute walk away, the Clichy-Levallois train stations and the Mairie de Clichy and Porte de Clichy metro stations make getting around easy. Shops, schools, and urban infrastructure are also located in the immediate vicinity.


