Property Description

Located in La Celle-les-Bordes, in the heart of an exceptional natural environment, this former coaching inn offers 312 sqm of living space. It flourishes on a wooded plot of 2,629 sqm, between landscaped gardens, undergrowth and relaxation areas, in a green and hilly setting typical of the Chevreuse Valley.

The immediate proximity of a castle steeped in history, as well as the presence of numerous outbuildings, give this property a rare character, at the crossroads of nature and heritage.

From the entrance, the house reveals a warm and authentic atmosphere, carried by a living room and a dining room bathed in light. Upstairs, four large bedrooms, two of which have private shower rooms, share two bathrooms and a separate toilet.

A charming boudoir, a discreet office and a fifth bedroom with a shower room, located on the second floor, complete the sleeping areas.

The exterior offers a veritable green setting with three distinct plant environments: a wellkept landscaped garden, an overhanging undergrowth, and a lower plot, ideal for leisure or gardening. A double garage with attic, a workshop, and a shed complete the amenities. Just 15 minutes from Rambouillet and Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse (RER B) train stations, this house offers the tranquility of the countryside while remaining close to the main roads leading to Paris.
