The exteriors, comprised of large terraces and a private garden (from 90m2 to 439m2), extend the living spaces. The large, bright living rooms combined with an optimized layout and quality finishes contribute to the standing and comfort of the villas. The garden has three levels and gives the possibility to place a swimming pool 'hors sol'. This means it is not in the ground but on the ground. You can create a lovely pool area with a sundeck around it at the same height as the higher level.


